Program details:

Day 1 – Saturday: Arrival

Individual arrival in Muscat, transfer to [Hotel Ramada Encore by Wyndham Al-Ghubra 4*](#) and check-in in a Standard room. Time at leisure to explore the hotel facilities and enjoy a dinner at *Olive restaurant*.

Day 2 – Sunday: Muscat Morning City Tour

After breakfast, we introduce you to Muscat during a morning half day city tour. It begins with a visit of the majestic **Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque**, a religious landmark of Muscat and splendor of unique Islamic architecture (*Ladies should cover their head with a scarf and wear long-sleeved clothes. Men should wear long trousers and t-shirt with sleeves, the mosque is closed on Friday*). We continue to **Mutrah Souq**, which is a great opportunity to buy frankincense, gold, silver and other souvenirs. Visit a museum to learn more about the history of the Sultanate and enjoy the drive along the beautiful Corniche to **old Muscat** for a photo stop at Al Alam Palace. On the way back to the hotel, we stop for a picture at the **Royal Opera House**.

Return to the hotel for time at leisure and benefit from the hotel facilities (gym, spa, rooftop pool). Dinner at *Olive restaurant* and overnight at **Hotel Ramada Encore by Wyndham Al Ghubra 4***, Standard room.

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Day 3 – Monday: Muscat - Bait Al Ghasham - Nakhl hot spring - Wadi Bani Awf - Nizwa / 250km-4.5h

After breakfast, we start the tour with a drive to the Batinah region for a visit of [Bait Al Ghasham Museum](#). It goes as far back as the reign of Sayyid Said Bin Sultan Al Busaidi (1791-1856) which means that the age of the house is around 200 years. Stop at the Nakhl hot springs before we continue to **Wadi Bani Awf**, where the off-road adventure is awaiting. After crossing the majestic mountains, we head to Nizwa for check-in, dinner and overnight at [Hotel Al Diyar 3*](#), Standard room.



Day 4 – Tuesday: Nizwa - Misfah Al Abriyeen - Al Hamra - Wadi Nakhr - Bahla - Jabreen - Nizwa - 160km/3h

After breakfast, we drive to **Misfah Al Abriyeen**, with its mud buildings and agricultural terraces on 1,000 meters height before we stop at **Al Hamra**, a 400-year-old town characterized by its mud houses and date plantations. Continue to visit the “The Grand Canyon” of Arabia from inside before we proceed to **Bahla** for a photo stop of a panoramic view, followed by the visit of the famous **castle of Jabreen**, built between 16th to 17th centuries by Imam Bal’ arab ibn Sultan. We return to **Nizwa** for dinner and overnight at [Hotel Al Diyar 3*](#), Standard room.



Day 5 – Wednesday: Nizwa Souq - Birkat Al Mouz - Al Mudayrib - Wahiba Sands / 190km-2:45h

After breakfast, we visit the local **Souq of Nizwa** that is renowned for its date souq, hand-carved “Khanjars” (daggers), pottery, ornamental silver jewelers and much more. Continue to **Birkat Al Mouz**, visit the UNESCO Falaj Al Katmain, and enjoy a drive through the palm plantations before heading in direction to the desert. We stop at **Al Mudayrib village**, which is a traditional Omani village where you can see palm trees, the Falaj water system and beautiful old doors, **Wahiba Sands**, located in the Al Sharqiya region. Experience sand dunes rising up to 200 meters

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that are also host to a variety of flora and fauna. Check-in for dinner and overnight at the camp [Arabian Oryx 3*](#), Standard room.



Day 6 – Thursday: Wahiba Sands - Wadi Bani Khalid - Wahiba Sands – 150km/3h

After breakfast, enjoy a thrilling ride for dune bashing before visiting a Bedouin Family (they provide the option for a camel ride at extra cost). Continue to **Wadi Bani Khalid**, a famous Wadi with clear deep blue water pools. Experience this oasis with a short trekking or/and swimming. *(Please bring a towel and wear covered clothes for both women and men in addition to your swimsuit.)* Return to the desert for time at leisure before sunset watching on top of the dunes. Dinner and overnight in the camp **Arabian Oryx 3***, Standard room.



Day 7 – Friday: Wahiba - Sur Dhow Factory - Wadi Tiwi - Bimah Sinkhole - Muscat / 360km-5h

After breakfast, we exit the desert and we drive to visit the famous **Dhow Factory** in Sur, where they still build traditional Arabian ships. Enjoy a drive along the coast to **Wadi Tiwi**, adjacent to the very popular Wadi Shab but unique in its own way with numerous farms and plantations. On the way back to Muscat, we stop at a huge sinkhole known as the **Bimmah Sinkhole**, specular limestone crater with blue green water at the bottom. We arrive in Muscat in the afternoon and drop you at the Muscat International Airport or your hotel in Muscat for extension nights.

Terms & Conditions:

Cancellations/No Shows/Changes:

1. Tourism Services may be changed or cancelled from time to time provided that valid reasons must be shared in advance. Parties may not send any cancellation notices invalidly and/or unreasonably.
2. Service Provider shall always have the right to seek a compensation equivalent of any total invoiced amount if the Service Receiver has decided to cancel or it is a no show for any of invoiced Tourism Service within the cancellation period of Service Provider or third party suppliers before the commencement date of such Tourism Services.
3. Any charges invoiced by third parties pertaining the cancelled Tourism Services will be always payable by the Party requested to cancel such Tourism Services.
4. In all events including Force Majeure, the Service Receiver is requested to pay the Service Provider any charges or costs incurred initially and to any Third-Party services providers but not limited to bookings charges, drivers (etc.).
5. Free cancellation/changes **until 30 days prior to arrival**. After booking confirmation, a non-refundable cancellation fee of OMR 20 will apply in case of cancellation after booking confirmation until 30 days prior to arrival. Later cancellation as per following breakdown: 30-0 days & no-show 100% cancellation fee applies.

Payments of invoices, billings and taxes:

1. Rates are incl. all taxes and non-commissionable.
2. Parties agree that entire invoices and bills issued between themselves must be paid and done in Omani Rials only. However, bank charges of 3% will be added and shall be always borne by the payer.
3. Parties agree that Service Provider will send an invoice for the Tourism Services based on proposed net rates as soon once the booking details are shared by the Service Receiver. Service Provider shall have an exclusive right to hold any obligations and carry out the agreed Tourism Services if any invoices were not settled.
4. Service Receiver agree to pay any invoices or/and billings for any Tourism Services as per payment details mentioned on the invoice/bill and **full payment until 35 days prior to arrival**.
5. Amounts payable to Service Provider must be done to its registered account or via cash money transfer as per the bank details mentioned in the invoice.

Force Majeure:

1. Without any prejudice to the obligations of the Parties set out in this Agreement, Service Provider shall remain free of any liability against any failure to perform any obligations resulting of Emergency Circumstances, Act's of God, acts of governments or other authorities, wars, weather conditions, hostilities, civil disturbances, strikes, riots epidemics, quarantines, COVID-19 restrictions issued by the governments and affecting the enforcement of this Agreement or as a result of any cause beyond the control ("**Events of Threats**").
2. Service Receiver realizes that Events of Threats could prohibit Service Provider from carrying out its obligations entirely or partially and therefore, assessment of liabilities shall not strictly made or calculated immediately against the Service Provider.

Travel & Health insurances/Visa:

1. All travelers arriving in the Sultanate of Oman are required to have the mandatory international health insurance incl. coverage of Covid19-treatments. Al Maamari Tours shall have no liability against any failure of insurance proof.
2. The passenger/guest has to strictly follow the implemented decisions & regulations taken by the Supreme Committee. In case of violating the quarantine regulations, Al Maamari Tours is not liable for any fines or punitive actions taken by the Omani authorities.
