DAY 01 CASABLANCA AIRPORT - CASABLANCA

- Welcome to Casablanca airport by your driver / guide, (who will be waiting for you at the exit with a sign in your name).
- Depending on your arrival time, enjoy a first glimpse of Morocco's largest city, known for its modern atmosphere, coastal charm, and impressive architecture.
- **Relax and prepare for an unforgettable journey through the Kingdom.**
- **Overnight at Casablanca Hotel.**

DAY 02 CASABLANCA - RABAT - TANGIER

- **Breakfast at Casablanca hotel.**
- **Day devoted to Casablanca & Rabat city tour.**
- Discover the impressive **Hassan II Mosque**, one of the largest and most beautiful mosques in the world, dramatically situated on the Atlantic coastline.
- Admire its remarkable architecture, intricate craftsmanship, and breathtaking ocean views. You may also enjoy a panoramic tour of the city, including its elegant boulevards and vibrant seaside atmosphere.
- **Continue to Rabat, the capital city of Morocco, where history and modernity blend harmoniously.**
- Visit **Chellah**, an ancient Roman settlement and medieval Islamic necropolis, where centuries of history come together amidst beautiful gardens, ancient ruins, and impressive archaeological remains.
- Explore the iconic **Hassan Tower**, the unfinished minaret dating back to the 12th century, and visit the magnificent **Mausoleum of Mohammed V**, a masterpiece of traditional Moroccan architecture.
- Stroll through the charming Kasbah of the Udayas, overlooking the Bou Regreg River and the Atlantic Ocean, **Continue to Tangier, the gateway between Africa and Europe, located at the meeting point of the Atlantic Ocean and the Mediterranean Sea.**
- **Overnight at Tangier Hotel.**



DAY 03 TANGIER

- **Breakfast at Tangier hotel.**
- **Enjoy a full-day guided tour of Tangier**, the legendary city where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Mediterranean Sea, renowned for its rich history, diverse cultural influences, and strategic location at the crossroads of Europe and Africa.
- Begin with a panoramic tour of the modern city, passing through elegant residential districts, the bustling port area, and **the scenic Corniche**.
- Visit **Cap Spartel**, a spectacular promontory offering breathtaking views over the Atlantic Ocean and the Strait of Gibraltar, where the waters of two seas converge.
- Continue to the famous **Caves of Hercules**, a fascinating natural site steeped in mythology and local legends.
- Explore the historic Medina of Tangier, wandering through its narrow alleys, lively souks, traditional markets, and charming squares while discovering the city's unique blend of Moroccan, Andalusian, and European heritage. Visit the Kasbah district, perched above the city, offering magnificent panoramic views of the coastline and harbor.
- Discover the vibrant **Grand Socco** and **Petit Socco**, historic gathering places surrounded by cafés, shops, and traditional architecture.
- In the afternoon, continue exploring the city's cultural and architectural landmarks, including its historic neighborhoods and hidden gems.
- **Overnight at Tangier Hotel.**



DAY 04 TANGIER - CHEFCHAOUEN - FEZ

- **Breakfast at Tangier hotel.**
- **Departure for Chefchaouen**, the enchanting "Blue Pearl" of Morocco, nestled in the heart of the Rif Mountains.
- Upon arrival, enjoy a guided walking tour through the picturesque Medina, famous for its blue-painted streets, charming alleyways, and peaceful atmosphere.
- Discover the historic **Outa El Hammam Square**, the vibrant heart of the city, surrounded by traditional cafés and local artisan shops.
- Visit **the Kasbah**, a restored fortress dating back to the 15th century, offering insight into the town's rich history and culture. Stroll through the winding streets of the Medina, where every corner reveals photogenic blue facades, colorful doorways, and authentic Moroccan craftsmanship.
- Free time for lunch (optional) and personal exploration, allowing you to soak in the unique charm of this mountain town.
- **In the afternoon, continue your journey towards Fez, Morocco's spiritual and cultural capital.**
- **Overnight at Fez Hotel.**



DAY 05 FEZ

- **Breakfast at Fez hotel.**
- Spend the day exploring the fascinating city of Fez, home to one of the world's oldest living medinas. Wander through the narrow alleyways of **Fes el Bali**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site filled with traditional souks, artisan workshops, and historic monuments.
- Visit the renowned **Al Quaraouiyine University**, the famous **Chouara Tanneries**, and the magnificent **Bou Inania Madrasa**, one of the most beautiful theological schools in Morocco, showcasing exceptional Islamic architecture and craftsmanship.
- Explore the magnificent **Bab Bou Jeloud (Blue Gate)**, the main entrance to the old medina, and admire its iconic blue and green mosaic decoration.
- Visit the elegant **Nejjarine Fountain** and discover the traditional arts and crafts that have been preserved for centuries. Enjoy a panoramic view of the medina from the historic Borj Nord, offering one of the best viewpoints over the city.
- Discover the **Jewish Quarter (Mellah)** and the impressive gates of the Royal Palace of Fez, famous for their ornate golden doors. Immerse yourself in the rich history, culture, and authentic atmosphere of Morocco's spiritual and cultural capital.
- **Overnight at Fez hotel.**



DAY 06 FEZ (DAY TRIP TO VOLUBILIS & MEKNES)

- **Breakfast at the hotel.**
- Depart for a full-day excursion to **Volubilis** and **Meknes**, two of Morocco's most remarkable historical and cultural treasures.
- Begin with a visit to **Volubilis**, the best-preserved Roman archaeological site in Morocco and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore its impressive ruins, including ancient temples, basilicas, triumphal arches, and beautifully preserved mosaics that offer a fascinating glimpse into Roman civilization in North Africa.
- **Continue to Meknes, one of Morocco's four Imperial Cities and the former capital of Sultan Moulay Ismail.**
- Discover the monumental **Bab Mansour Gate**, considered one of the most magnificent gateways in Morocco, renowned for its exquisite decorative details.
- Visit the historic **El Hedim Square** and admire the architectural heritage of the Imperial City.
- In the afternoon, continue exploring the highlights of Meknes, including its historic ramparts, granaries, and royal stables, reflecting the grandeur of the city's imperial past.
- **Return to Fez in the late afternoon.**
- **Overnight at Fez Hotel.**



DAY 07 FEZ – IFRANE – MIDELT – MERZOUGA

- **Breakfast at Fez hotel.**
- **Depart Fez and journey south through the scenic Middle Atlas Mountains.**
- Stop in **Ifrane**, often called the "Switzerland of Morocco" for its alpine-style architecture and clean streets. Continue through cedar forests and mountain landscapes to **Midelt** before crossing the spectacular **Ziz Valley**, famous for its vast palm groves and panoramic views.
- Arrive in **Merzouga**, gateway to the majestic Sahara Desert, where golden dunes stretch as far as the eye can see. **In the late afternoon, enjoy a memorable camel ride across the stunning Erg Chebbi dunes and witness a breathtaking sunset over the Sahara.**
- As the sun paints the sand in shades of gold and orange, experience the magical atmosphere of the desert before returning to your camp.
- **Dinner & Overnight at Merzouga hotel.**



DAY 08 MERZOUGA

- **Breakfast at Merzouga Camp.**
- **Half day devoted to explore Merzouga by 4x4.**
- The tour starts in Merzouga where we pick you up in the morning and depart to the **Erg Chebbi** dunes.
- We will go around the desert and be able to admire how the dunes stand in sharp contrast to the blue sky. We will visit **the Berber nomads** who live in the desert, spend some time with them to learn their secrets, manners and enjoy their hospitality. Continue to the village of **Khamlia**, known for its authentic atmosphere and rich cultural heritage, where you will have the opportunity to discover local traditions and experience the unique lifestyle of its inhabitants.
- You will also visit the black volcanic rock locations and the Lake Merzouga, which in springtime sparkles in the bright sunlight.
- **In the evening, savor a traditional Moroccan dinner under the stars.**
- **Dinner & Overnight at Merzouga camp.**



DAY 09 MERZOUGA – TODRA GORGES – OUARZAZATE

- **Breakfast at Merzouga Camp.**
- **Departure to Ouarzazate.**
- After breakfast, leave the desert behind and travel towards the spectacular **Todra Gorge**, where towering canyon walls create one of Morocco's most impressive natural wonders.
- Continue through the **Valley of Roses** and the Road of a **Thousand Kasbahs**, passing charming villages and dramatic landscapes.
- **Arrive in Ouarzazate**, often referred to as the "Gateway to the Sahara."
- **Dinner & Overnight at Ouarzazate camp.**



DAY 10 OUARZAZATE - AIT BEN HADDOU - MARRAKECH

- **Breakfast at Ouarzazate hotel.**
- Visit the outside of the **Kasbahs Taourirt**, and finally the **Kasbah of Ait Benhaddou**, the most spectacular fortress in the South of Morocco, which has served as décor for many films like 'Lawrence of Arabia'.
- Lunch at the terrace of the restaurant facing the Kasbah (not included).
- Departures to Marrakesh via the **Tizin'Tichka** pass offering an impressive landscape in the heart of the Atlas Mountains.
- **Check in at the hotel.**
- **Overnight at Marrakech hotel.**



DAY 11 MARRAKECH

- **Breakfast at Marrakech hotel.**
- **Day devoted to Marrakech city tour.**
- Marrakesh is the second oldest Imperial city, known as the Pearl of the South. The city was founded by the Almoravides at the end of the 11th century. The historical sightseeing includes:
- **The Menara Garden** is a large garden planted with olive trees, and at the heart of this garden, a large pond at the foot of a pavilion.
- **The Koutoubia Mosque** is a religious building built in the 12th century, its architecture and its ascetic decoration undergone the art of the Almohades from a height of 77 meters (253 feet).
- **The Bahia Palace** is an old 19th century palace of eight hectares in Islamic style. Currently a museum.
- Visit **the Mellah and the Jewish quarter**, the narrow streets of Mellah were once home to the residences of the city's Jewish population, as evidenced by several sites of interest such as the Salat Al Azama synagogue, with its tiled courtyard and exhibits on Jewish life, and the peaceful Miaara Jewish cemetery.
- Visit **the souks** and handicraft quarters, displaying a variety of items and the famous **place Djemaa El Fna** with its nonstop entertainment.
- **Overnight at Marrakech hotel.**



DAY 12 MARRAKECH - ESSAOUIRA

- **Breakfast at Marrakech hotel.**
- **Departure to Essaouira, the charming coastal town on Morocco's Atlantic coast, renowned for its laid-back atmosphere, historic heritage, and picturesque seaside setting.**
- Upon arrival, enjoy a guided tour of the UNESCO-listed Medina, famous for its whitewashed buildings with blue shutters, narrow streets, and vibrant artisan workshops. Stroll through the historic **Skala de la Ville**, the impressive 18th-century seafront ramparts lined with ancient cannons and offering spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean.
- Explore the bustling **fishing port**, where colorful blue boats, local fishermen, and fresh seafood create an authentic maritime atmosphere. Wander through the lively souks and discover traditional craftsmanship, including thuya woodwork, jewelry, textiles, and local art galleries.
- Visit the picturesque **Moulay Hassan Square**, the heart of the Medina, surrounded by cafés, restaurants, and historic buildings.
- Enjoy the relaxed ambiance of this former Portuguese trading port, whose unique blend of Moroccan, African, Arab, and European influences have earned it a special place among Morocco's most captivating destinations.
- **Overnight at Essaouira Hotel.**



DAY 13 ESSAOUIRA - MARRAKECH

- **Breakfast at Essaouira hotel.**
- **Morning at leisure.**
- In the afternoon, depart for Marrakech, travelling through the scenic countryside and argan tree landscapes of western Morocco.
- **Upon arrival in Marrakech, check in at the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.**
- **Overnight at Marrakech Hotel.**

DAY 14 DEPARTURE

- **Breakfast at Marrakech hotel.**
- **After breakfast, transfer to Marrakech or Casablanca Airport for your departure flight.**
