Additional Information – Ljubljana:

In December, Ljubljana transforms into a true sea of lights. Golden strings of lights stretch across the bridges, the castle glows on its hill, and the old town sparkles along the riverbank. Each year features a different theme for the light installations.

The Christmas market winds through the heart of the city—a labyrinth of wooden stalls offering handmade jewelry, wool scarves, and local crafts. Free concerts of all kinds take place on five stages across the squares. The Christmas markets are open at least until December 31st.

The spectacular New Year's Eve fireworks are organized centrally from the Castle Hill, making them visible from many parts of the city. The castle itself is also illuminated in many colors.

On January 1st, while shops and some restaurants are closed, excursions such as Bled or Postojna can still take place.

City Tour of Ljubljana and Boat Cruise on the Ljubljanica

There is much to discover in the Slovenian capital, which you will get to know on an extensive city walking tour. The lively atmosphere of the Christmas market can certainly be enhanced with a cup of mulled wine. To conclude the tour, you will take the cable car up to Castle Hill, ascending around 70 meters in altitude in just one minute. The next highlight is a panoramic boat cruise on the Ljubljanica River. The interesting bridges and picturesque riverbanks give Ljubljana its unmistakable character, further emphasized by the festive illumination.

Bled and Lake Bled

Journey to the fairytale Lake Bled. Enjoy a walk along the lakeshore with wonderful views of the surrounding Julian Alps. Directly on the lakeshore, the Bled Christmas market awaits you in a magical atmosphere, with Bled Island, the wishing bell, and the castle providing a picturesque backdrop. Here you will have the opportunity to taste the famous Bled cream cake (Blejska kremšnita) at a stand run by a local bakery.

Take a ride in a traditional pletna boat to the island and visit the church with its wishing bell. Afterwards, visit Slovenia's oldest castle, including its museum, which towers high above the lake.

Postojna Cave and Predjama Castle

The Postojna Caves are the second-largest known dripstone caves in the world that are open to tourists. The entire cave system is 24 kilometers long. The accessible and open section covers 5 km, of which 3.5 km are traveled by train. Around 175 animal species live within the cave system, including the blind olm. An impressive natural phenomenon experienced at a constant temperature of 10°C.

Just a few kilometers from Postojna Cave, the Karst region offers an unforgettable experience in a fairytale world of knights. Perched in a 123-meter-high vertical rock face stands an impregnable medieval marvel over 800 years old. Behind the largest cave castle in the world lies a network of secret passages from which the knight Erasmus of Predjama set out on his raids.

Continue on to Vipavski Križ, a charming medieval village overlooking the Vipava Valley. Enjoy a short walk that concludes with a wine tasting featuring wines from the Vipava Valley.

Škofja Loka and Gingerbread Workshop in Radovljica

Škofja Loka is one of Slovenia's oldest and most charming towns, known for its beautifully preserved medieval old town, its colorful houses, and the fairytale Škofja Loka Castle overlooking the valley.

Our journey continues to Radovljica, where we visit the famous Lectar workshop. This family-run artisan bakery continues to produce traditional decorated gingerbread hearts (lectova srca) using age-old recipes and techniques. You will also have the opportunity to purchase these unique handmade souvenirs.

The Lipica Stud Farm and Piran – a Jewel on Slovenia's Adriatic Coast

After breakfast, you will visit the Lipica Stud Farm, the birthplace of the world-famous Lipizzaner horses. The guided tour takes you to the paddocks, the farrier's workshop, the mares' stables, and the stallion stables. Along the way, you will learn interesting facts about the breeding, care, and dressage of the approximately 200 Lipizzaners, as well as about the history of the stud farm.

Afterwards, continue on to the beautiful town of Piran. Once a bustling Venetian customs port, Piran now enchants visitors with its winding medieval streets, elegant Venetian architecture, and seaside charm. It offers a perfect blend of culture, romance, and timeless beauty.
